The park has now developed a luxury hotel and high-end cabins that allow families to stay as close as possible to the animals! This new accommodation offer meets the wishes of the park's visitors, which has become so vast that it's difficult to visit it in a single day, especially for foreign visitors who have to join Pairi Daiza from Paris or Amsterdam.
